2017 Registration Fees

As of Monday 12th December, we have had our registration fees for season 2017 approved by Newcastle Football.

We are hopeful that everyone will be pleased to see no increase of fees from Football Federation Australia, Northern NSW Football & Newcastle Football for another year.

The committee also made the decision late in season 2016 to move away from having clothes included in the registration fees, therefore the costs for the majority of our parents in season 2017 will be lower than in previous years.

In 2017, the committee has also made the decision to take all our final registration payments online through the MyFootballClub portal during the registration process you undertake every season.

This means that your online registration must be completed by Wednesday 1st March, 2017 to ensure that your child is paid for and eligible to take part in the first round of the season on Saturday 22nd April.

The reasoning behind the 1st of March date is that all our teams need to be submitted to Newcastle Football by Friday 11th March – Therefore giving the committee time to prepare all the paperwork that is required to be submitted.
